- ONE ZIP PER PROJECT Always combine your files into a zip before sending to ensure nothing is left behind.
- MAKE DESCRIPTIVE FILE NAMES Always include your company name, the name of your salesperson and a reference to your project in zip file name.
- **ALERT YOUR SALESPERSON** Let your salesperson know before you send us files so that they can let us know to expect them.
- OUTLINE YOUR FONTS Providing your files with fonts outlined helps us to ensure that what you see on your screen is what we produce on press.
- INCLUDE A PDF PROOF A PDF proof can help us ensure the included mechanical files are correct.
- INCLUDE .EPS OR .AI FILES See our Art Format & Design Guidelines pdf for tips on providing us with files that will look their very best on press.
